Small Blue Border Quilt

Finished Quilt Size: 34" x 34"

Finished Block Size: 4"

Materials & Cutting:

Brown Nest (BD/D#1) - 1/3 yard

-cut nine 4 1/2" squares

Dark Pink Floral (BD/G#1) - 1/2 yard

-cut thirty-six 2 1/2" squares

-cut four 2 1/4" strips for binding

Blue Petals "Eggs" (BD/E#1) - 1/4 yard

Yellow Bird Allover (BD/B#3) - 1/2 yard

-cut six 5 1/2" squares, cut each square into quarters on the diagonal for a total of 24 triangles

-cut twenty-four 2 1/2" squares

-cut four 5 1/2" squares for corners

Green Vine (BD/C#3) - 1/3 yard

-cut six 5 1/2" squares, cut each square into quarters on the diagonal for a total of 24 triangles

-cut twelve 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Blue Border Print (BD/#1) - 1 1/2 yards

-cut off selvage plus 1/4" then cut four borders 5 1/2" x 24 1/2" - 2 birds nests on each border

-cut four 4 1/2" squares from center of fabric

-cut four 2 1/2" squares from center of fabric

-cut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles from center of fabric

Backing - 1 1/4 yards

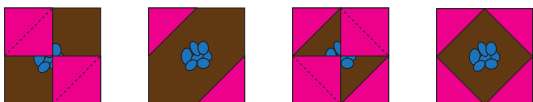
Fusible Web

Block A

1. Iron fusible web to back of Blue Egg fabric. Cut out six groups of eggs. Fuse one to center of each brown square. Zigzag around the raw edges of the eggs.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Dark Pink Floral square. Place a pink square on a corner of each brown square with right sides together. Stitch on the diagonal line and press to the outside of the block. Trim middle layer. Repeat for all four corners.



Block B

1. Stitch together a Yellow Bird Allover triangle to each Green Vine triangle.
2. Stitch sets together.



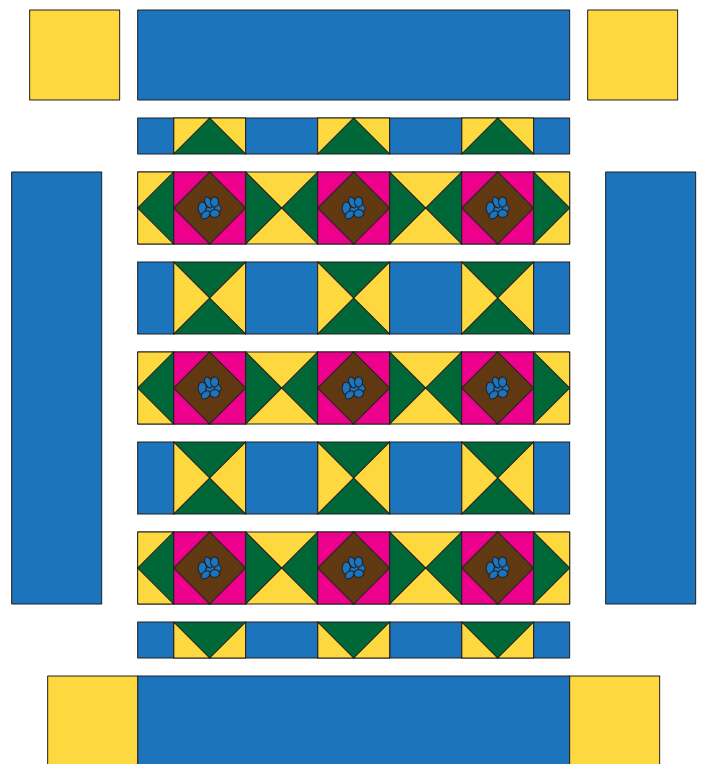
Inner Border

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the Yellow Bird Allover squares. Place a yellow square on one corner of each Green Vine rectangle with right sides together. Stitch on the diagonal line and press to the outside of the block. Trim middle layer. Repeat for the other corner.



Finishing It All Up

1. Stitch together in rows then stitch rows together.
2. Attach final outside borders.



3. Layer with batting and backing and quilt as desired.
4. Bind with Dark Pink Floral.
5. ENJOY!

Large Yellow Border Quilt

Finished Quilt Size: 48" x 48"

Finished Block Size: 6"

Materials & Cutting:

Green Nest (BD/D#2) – ½ yard

-cut nine 6½" squares

Light Pink Floral (BD/G#2) - ½ yard

-cut thirty-six 3½" squares

Blue Petals "Eggs" (BD/E#1) - ¼ yard

-cut five 2¼" strips for binding

Pink Bird Allover (BD/B#3) – 1 yard

-cut six 7¼" squares, cut each square into quarters on the diagonal for a total of 24 triangles

-cut twenty-four 3½" squares

-cut four 6½" squares for corners

Blue Vine (BD/C#1) - ½ yard

-cut six 7¼" squares, cut each square into quarters on the diagonal for a total of 24 triangles

-cut twelve 3½" x 6½" rectangles

Yellow Border Print (BD/#1) – 2¼ yards

-cut off selvage then cut four borders

6½" x 36½" – 3 birds nests on each border

-cut four 6½" squares from center of fabric

-cut four 3½" squares from center of fabric

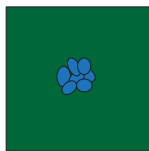
-cut eight 3½" x 6½" rectangles from center of fabric

Backing - 2½ yards

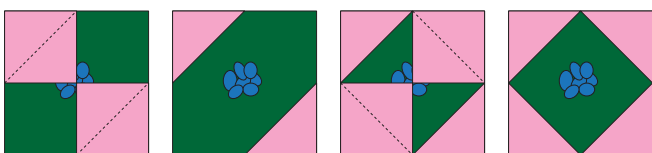
Fusible Web

Block A

1. Iron fusible web to back of Blue Egg fabric. Cut out six groups of eggs. Fuse one to center of each green square. Zigzag around the raw edges of the eggs.



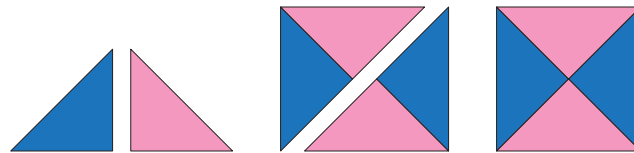
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Light Pink Floral square. Place a pink square on a corner of each green square with right sides together. Stitch on the diagonal line and press to the outside of the block. Trim middle layer. Repeat for all four corners.



Block B

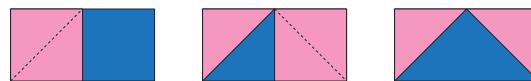
1. Stitch together a Pink Bird Allover triangle to each Blue Vine triangle.

2. Stitch sets together.



Inner Border

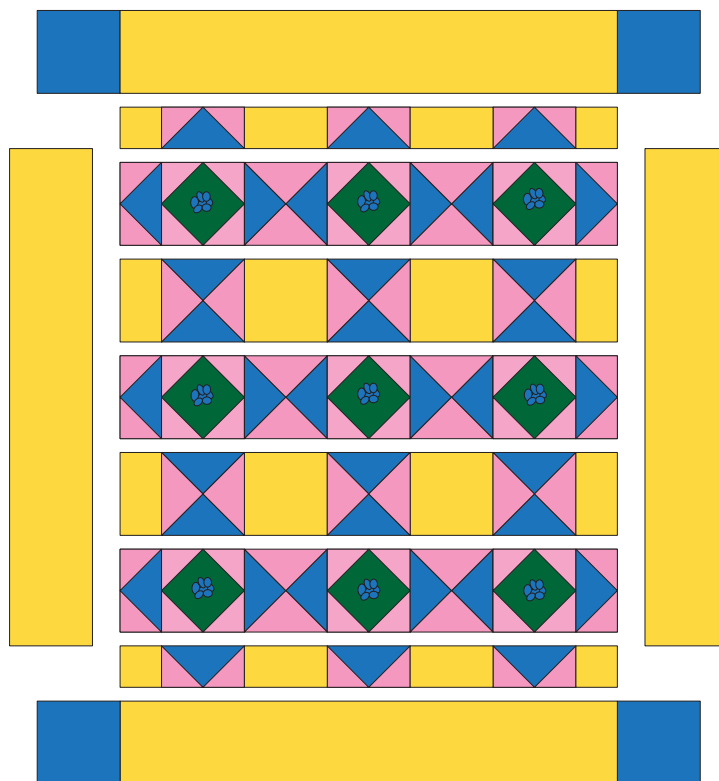
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the Pink Bird Allover squares. Place a pink square on one corner of each Blue Vine rectangle with right sides together. Stitch on the diagonal line and press to the outside of the block. Trim middle layer. Repeat for the other corner.



Finishing It All Up

1. Stitch together in rows then stitch rows together.

2. Attach final outside borders.



3. Layer with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

4. Bind with Blue Petal fabric.

5. ENJOY!
